








Figure 3. U.S. National Average AEWR and Year-Over-Year Change in National AEWR, 2005-2024










Figure 5. Number of States in Each AEWR Range, 2022-2024






Figure 6. Percentage Increase in 2024 AEWR Over 2023 AEWR




Figure 7. Dollar-Per-Hour Increase in 2024 AEWR Over 2023 AEWR







Figure 9. Fiscal Year 2023 H-2A Certified Positions






Figure 11. Change in Number of H-2A Certified
